

Case Study: Haberdashers' Aske's School for Girls

Pinnacle were chosen by Haberdashers' Aske's School for Girls to fit-out their new build STEM block, main science building and associated prep rooms.

Pinnacle were invited to tender for this scheme which had been developed with IID Architects along with a different laboratory manufacturer. After being successfully shortlisted we presented directly to the construction, design, and client team after which we were appointed. We supplied and installed fitted and freestanding furniture to all three buildings. Each science discipline had different requirements, physics required more freestanding tables to offer flexibility for room use, biology wanted glass fronted wall units to display specimens and chemistry needed extensive Gratnell trays to store equipment.
